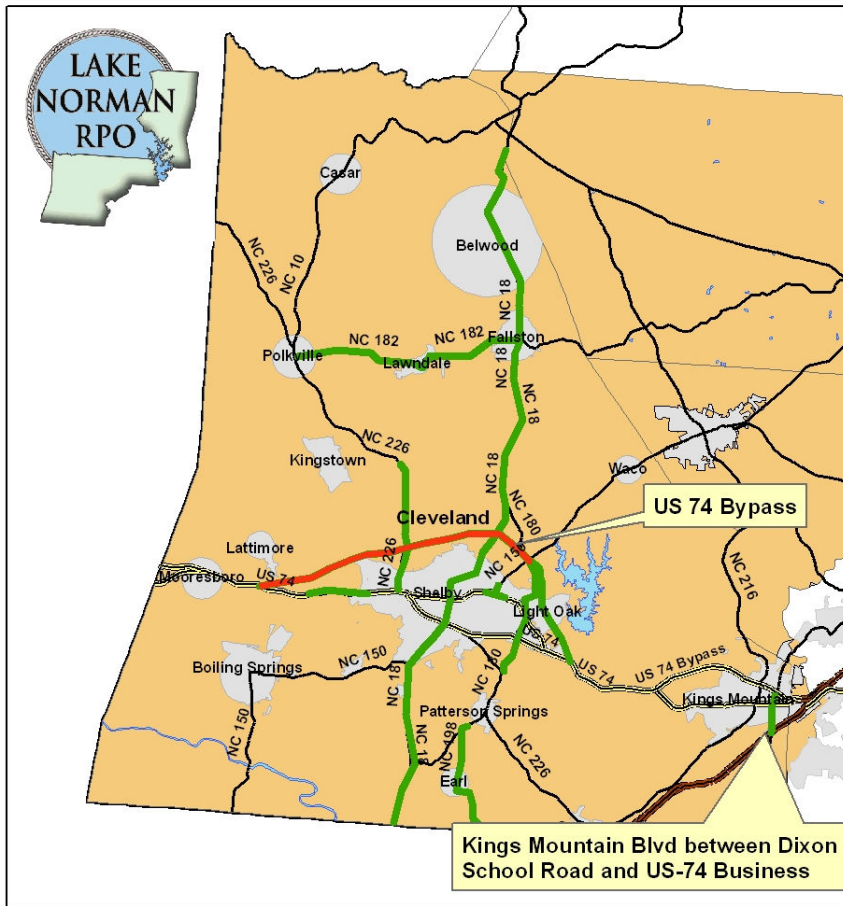

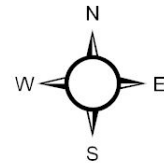

## Legend

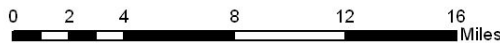
- Lake Norman RPO
